Human-Caused Ignitions

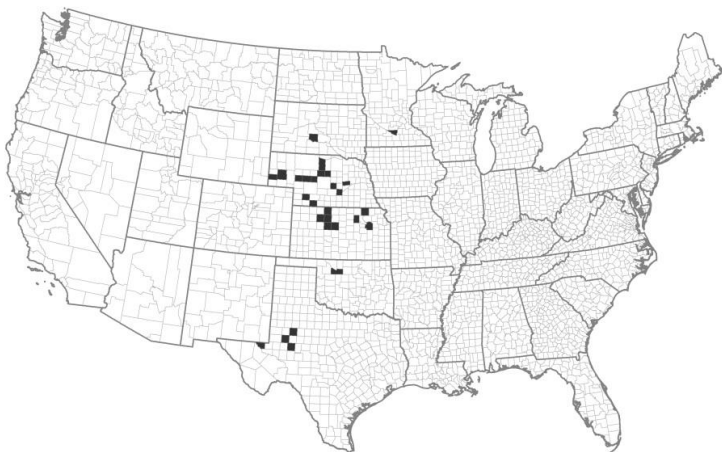
Reduce human-caused incendiary ignitions by focusing on enforcement programs.
