Human-Caused Ignitions

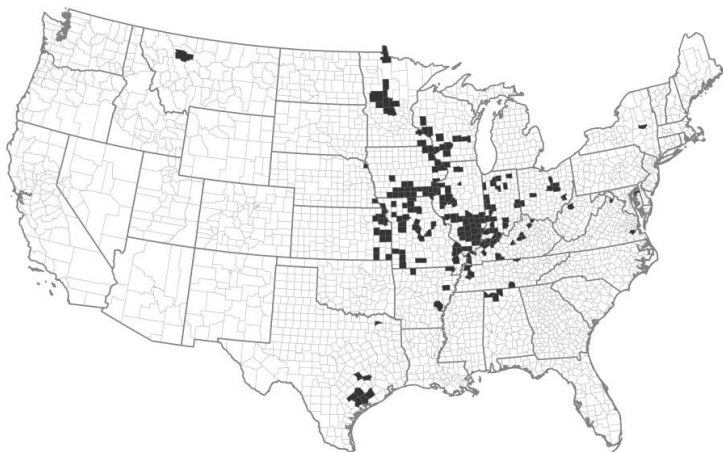
Human caused ignitions are a problem in these counties. Reduce accidental and human-caused ignitions through enforcement or outreach.
